AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. MORAN

Viz:

- 1 At the end of subtitle C of title XII, add the fol-
- 2 lowing:
- 3 **SEC. 1237. INTELLIGENCE ASSESSMENT AND REPORT ON**
- 4 **AL-SHABAAB.**
- 5 (a) INTELLIGENCE ASSESSMENT.—Not later than
- 6 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
- 7 Director of National Intelligence shall submit to the ap-
- 8 propriate committees of Congress a classified intelligence
- 9 assessment of the terrorist organization known as Al-
- 10 Shabaab. Such assessment shall include the following:

1           (1) A description of organizational structure,  
2           operational objectives, and funding sources for Al-  
3           Shabaab.

4           (2) An assessment of the extent to which Al-  
5           Shabaab threatens security and stability within So-  
6           malia and surrounding countries.

7           (3) An assessment of the extent to which Al-  
8           Shabaab threatens the security of United States citi-  
9           zens or the national security or interests of the  
10          United States.

11          (4) The description of the relationship between  
12          Al-Shabaab and Al-Qaeda and Al-Qaeda affiliates.

13          (5) An assessment of the capacity of the Gov-  
14          ernment of Somalia to counter the threat posed by  
15          Al-Shabaab.

16          (6) An assessment of the capacity of regional  
17          countries and organizations, including the African  
18          Union, to counter the threat posed by Al-Shabaab.

19          (b) SECRETARY OF STATE AND SECRETARY OF DE-  
20          FENSE JOINT REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the  
21          date on which the intelligence assessment required by sub-  
22          section (a) is submitted, the Secretary of State and the  
23          Secretary of Defense, jointly, shall submit to the appro-  
24          priate committees of Congress a report describing the

1 strategy of the United States to counter the threat posed  
2 by Al-Shabaab.

3 (c) APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES OF CONGRESS DE-  
4 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate commit-  
5 tees of Congress” means—

6 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
7 Committee on Foreign Relations, and the Select  
8 Committee on Intelligence of the Senate; and

9 (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the  
10 Committee on Foreign Affairs, and the Permanent  
11 Select Committee on Intelligence of the House of  
12 Representatives.
