
Dear Ms. Rogers:

I write on behalf of the Cowley County (KS) Drug Court Program's application to the Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program as administered by the Bureau of Justice Assistance. The purpose of the submission is for enhancing drug court services, coordination, management of drug court participants, and recovery support services.

Support from the Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program would allow the Cowley County Drug Court Program to increase the capacity of individuals they are able to serve from 30 participants to 40 participants. The funds would also be used to increase drug testing of participants, hire an external evaluator to assess the overall effectiveness of the program, as well as a number of other crucial operational items. This proposal would provide critical support in combatting opioid and methamphetamine addiction and in turn increase public safety.
