Thank you for your letter dated, April 13, 2018, regarding the mission of our Military Funeral Honors (MFH) coordinators.

The 2016 Army Audit Agency report you reference recommended the Army National Guard (ARNG) consider cutting the number of coordinators. The ARNG decided not to reduce the MFH coordinators as we agree this is a critical mission. Some under-utilized coordinators may take on additional duties to better balance workload, but the ARNG has no plan to remove coordinators from states.
