AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. MORAN (for himself, Mr. INHOFE, Mr. BLUMENTHAL, Mr. BLUNT, Mr. BOOZMAN, Mr. KIRK, Mr. PRYOR, and Mr. ROBERTS)

Viz:

1 At the end of title VIII of division F, add the fol-
2 lowing:

3 SEC. 1811. (a) Notwithstanding section 1101, the
4 level for “Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation
5 Administration, Operations” shall be \$9,703,395,000:
6 *Provided*, That the amounts specified in the matter under
7 the heading “OPERATIONS” under the heading “FEDERAL
8 AVIATION ADMINISTRATION” in title I of the Transpor-
9 tation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related

1 Agencies Appropriations Act, 2012 (division C of Public
2 Law 112–55; 125 Stat. 645) shall be applied to funds ap-
3 propriated by this division—

4 (1) by substituting “\$7,492,738,000” for
5 “\$7,442,738,000”; and

6 (2) by substituting “\$10,350,000 shall be for
7 the contract tower cost-sharing program and not less
8 than \$130,000,000 shall be for the contract tower
9 program” for “\$10,350,000 shall be for the contract
10 tower cost-sharing program”.

11 (b) Of amounts appropriated for fiscal years before
12 fiscal year 2013 that remain available for obligation as
13 of the date of the enactment of this Act and that are not
14 designated an emergency requirement pursuant to a con-
15 current resolution on the budget or the Balanced Budget
16 and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985, the following
17 amounts are rescinded from the following accounts:

18 (1) “Department of Transportation, Federal
19 Aviation Administration, Facilities and Equipment”,
20 \$23,861,002.

21 (2) “Department of Transportation, Federal
22 Aviation Administration, Research, Engineering, and
23 Development”, \$26,183,998.
