AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. MORAN

Viz:

- 1 At the end of subtitle A of title IV, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 402. REVISION IN PERMANENT ACTIVE DUTY END**
- 3 **STRENGTH MINIMUM LEVELS.**
- 4 Section 691(b) of title 10, United States Code, is
- 5 amended by striking paragraphs (1) through (4) and in-
- 6 serting the following:
- 7 “(1) For the Army, 480,000.
- 8 “(2) For the Navy, 324,615.
- 9 “(3) For the Marine Corps, 185,000.
- 10 “(4) For the Air Force, 321,000.”.

1 **SEC. 403. SUPERSEDING FISCAL YEAR 2017 END**  
2 **STRENGTHS FOR CERTAIN ELEMENTS OF**  
3 **THE SELECTED RESERVE.**

4 (a) INEFFECTIVENESS OF CERTAIN END  
5 STRENGTHS.—Paragraphs (1) through (6) of section  
6 411(a) shall have no force or effect.

7 (b) SUPERSEDING END STRENGTHS.—The Armed  
8 Forces specified are authorized strengths for Selected Re-  
9 serve personnel of the reserve components as of September  
10 30, 2017, as follows:

11 (1) The Army National Guard of the United  
12 States, 350,000.

13 (2) The Army Reserve, 205,000.

14 (3) The Navy Reserve, 58,000.

15 (4) The Marine Corps Reserve, 38,500.

16 (5) The Air National Guard of the United  
17 States, 105,700.

18 (6) The Air Force Reserve, 69,000.

19 (c) APPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN AUTHORITIES.—  
20 Subsections (b) and (c) of section 411 shall apply in the  
21 calculation of end strengths under subsection (b) of this  
22 section.
