AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. RISCH (for himself, Mr. RUBIO, Mr. CORNYN, Mr. BLUNT, Mr. MORAN, Ms. AYOTTE, Mr. VITTER, Mrs. FISCHER, Mr. JOHNSON of Wisconsin, and Mr. CRAPO)

- 1 At the end of subtitle C of title XXII, add the fol-
- 2 lowing:
- 3 **SEC. 1237. REPORT ON INF TREATY COMPLIANCE INFORMA-**
- 4 **TION SHARING.**
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the
- 6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State,
- 7 in coordination with the Secretary of Defense and the Di-
- 8 rector of National Intelligence, shall submit to the appro-

1 priate congressional committees a report on information
2 and intelligence sharing with North Atlantic Treaty Orga-
3 nization (NATO) and NATO countries on compliance
4 issues related to the INF Treaty.

5 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required under sub-
6 section (a) shall include the following elements:

7 (1) A description of all compliance and consist-
8 ency issues associated with the INF Treaty, includ-
9 ing a listing and assessment of all Ground Launched
10 Russian Federation Systems being designed, tested,
11 or deployed with ranges between 500 kilometers and
12 5,500 kilometers.

13 (2) An assessment of INF Treaty compliance
14 and consistency information sharing among NATO
15 countries, including—

16 (A) sharing among specific NATO coun-
17 tries and the NATO Secretariat;

18 (B) the date specific information was
19 shared; and

20 (C) the manner in which such information
21 was transmitted.

22 (3) If any information on INF Treaty compli-
23 ance or consistency was withheld from a specific
24 NATO country or the NATO Secretariat, a justifica-
25 tion for why such information was withheld.

1 (c) UPDATES.—Not later than 180 days and one year
2 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
3 of State, in coordination with the Secretary of Defense
4 and the Director of National Intelligence, shall provide to
5 the appropriate congressional committees updates to the
6 report submitted under subsection (a).

7 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

8 (1) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-
9 TEES.—The term “appropriate congressional com-
10 mittees” means—

11 (A) the congressional defense committees;

12 (B) the Committee on Foreign Relations
13 and the Select Committee on Intelligence of the
14 Senate; and

15 (C) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and
16 the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence
17 of the House of Representatives.

18 (2) INF TREATY.—The term “INF Treaty”
19 means the Treaty Between the United States of
20 America and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics
21 on the Elimination of their Intermediate-Range and
22 Shorter-Range Missiles, signed at Washington De-
23 cember 8, 1987.
