A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Reducing Antiquated
5 Permitting for Infrastructure Deployments Act" or the
6 "RAPID Act".

1 **SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS**
2 **COMMISSION REGARDING UNDERTAKINGS**
3 **AND MAJOR FEDERAL ACTIONS.**

4 (a) **FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION DE-**
5 **TERMINATION.—**

6 (1) **DEFINITIONS.—**In this section—

7 (A) the term “Commission” means the
8 Federal Communications Commission; and

9 (B) the term “radio station license” has
10 the meaning given the term in section 3 of the
11 Communications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 153).

12 (b) **PROCEEDING REQUIRED.—**Notwithstanding sec-
13 tion 300320 of title 54, United States Code, or section
14 102 of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42
15 U.S.C. 4332), not later than 180 days after the date of
16 enactment of this Act, the Commission shall complete a
17 proceeding to determine—

18 (1) the classes of activities of the entities to
19 which the Commission issues radio station licenses
20 that do not constitute an undertaking under such
21 section 300320; and

22 (2) the classes of activities of the entities to
23 which the Commission issues radio station licenses
24 that do not constitute a major Federal action under
25 paragraph (2)(C) of such section 102.
